The example of Job

James 5:11

Indeed we count them blessed who endure. You have heard of the perseverance of Job and seen the end intended by the Lord—that the Lord is very compassionate and merciful.

Keep on keeping on

- Do not throw in the towel
- Do not give up
- Do not take the law into your own hands
- Vengeance belongs to God

What makes things difficult to bear

- Have I been cursed?
- What sins have I committed?
- Why is it taking so long?
- Are things going to get any better

Hebrews 11:32 - 40

- 32 ¶ And what more shall I say? For the time would fail me to tell of Gideon and Barak and Samson and Jephthah, also of David and Samuel and the prophets:
- 33 who through faith subdued kingdoms, worked righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,
- 34 quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, became valiant in battle, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.
- 35 Women received their dead raised to life again. And others were tortured, not accepting deliverance, that they might obtain a better resurrection.
- 36 Still others had trial of mockings and scourgings, yes, and of chains and imprisonment.

Hebrews 11:32 - 40

- 37 They were stoned, they were sawn in two, were tempted, were slain with the sword. They wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins, being destitute, afflicted, tormented—
- 38 of whom the world was not worthy. They wandered in deserts and mountains, in dens and caves of the earth.
- 39 And all these, having obtained a good testimony through faith, did not receive the promise,
- 40 God having provided something better for us, that they should not be made perfect apart from us.

We make a choice and take a stand

- Sometimes we make a choice and take a stand because the alternative is no alternative at all
 - Curse God and die? No, no, no
 - We know that our God is able but we will not bow down and worship you
 - Moses made a choice when he refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter. He suffered the consequences for a great while but the rewards came

We make a choice and take a stand - cont

Hebrews 11:24 - 27

- 24 By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter,
- 25 choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin,
- 26 esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt; for he looked to the reward.
- 27 By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured as seeing Him who is invisible.

Some brutal questions

- Is this business worth it?
- Remember that others have turned back
- Is all this self denial and denying myself worth it
 - All the fastings
 - What about the tithing
 - And Church attendance
- Shall I continue in poverty?
 - My friends have taken sugar daddy's or sugar mummies
 - Why can't I play the system like others
 - I cannot going through life being childless

Some brutal questions ~ continued

- Why should I stay in the loveless marriage?
 - He is a brute, does not contribute anything at all to the marriage
 - She is a Jezebel, does what she likes and we really are not a couple
 - I am financially independent anyway
 - My friends have left their spouses and they seem to be happy so why should I be happy
 - After all I can get remarried. Others have done it.
 Preachers have done it and God is using them

You have need of patience

- We need to be patient
- We need to persevere
- We need to endure

How do we continue?

<u>Hebrews 12:1 - 2</u>

- 1¶ Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,
- 2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God
